eet the Abplanalps! Brian, Ashley, Reese (14), Sophia (10) and Wesley (9) live in the Hallsley subdivision. Brian and Ashley met during their freshman year at Virginia Tech. Brian lived on the same floor of the dorms as a high school friend of Ashley's. That friend paired the two for a Pi Kappa Phi fraternity event, and the young sweethearts were set. They married on December 9, 2000, not too long after graduation.

At Virginia Tech, Brian earned a bachelor's in management science and information technology. Ashley earned a bachelor's in science, double majoring in business management and sociology.

The couple lived in Northern Virginia for three years after getting married and moved to Richmond in 2003. "We wanted to get away from the long commutes, expensive housing, and endless traffic but still desired to be within driving distance of our extended family and friends. We drew a circle on a map that represented the boundaries of our move and we began our search for a new place to call home," said Brian. Once the couple chose Richmond as their destination, Brian was able to make arrangements with his employer to work remotely from home, Ashley landed a Human Resource position with the Richmond Times Dispatch, and the couple was off on their new adventure.

Brian works for CGI Technology Solutions, the same company he started working for 20 years ago, and is now the Director of an Information Technology Call Center. The call center is staffed with employees from around the world and it fields support calls from some

of the company's North American clients. Brian has continued to work from his home office since moving to Richmond sixteen years ago and he notes that the work arrangement established with his employer turned out to be one of the greatest blessings. He says that it has provided him with the opportunity to be there for his children and wife in a way that would not have been possible working outside of the house.

In addition to work, Brian has recently been active as a founding member of a new father/son and father/daughter outdoor adventure program called Wilderness Warriors. Focused on building strong bonds between fathers and their children, the program is centered around outdoor camping events that occur twice annually, as well as other fun activities that occur throughout the year. The camping events are currently



being held at Chanco on the James, which is situated on a one hundred twenty five acre tract along the James River. The events offered during the camping weekends include canoeing, archery, hatchet throwing, ziplines, camp fires and many other fun activities to keep the kids engaged. During the inaugural campouts this past fall, there were four hundred registered participants who attended!

Due to overwhelming interest, the program is expanding from two weekends to four weekends next fall to accommodate additional families that would like to participate.

Ashley is a money coach and speaker at The Money Mom, a personal finance coaching and training company she started in 2012 after her family became free of consumer debt and student loans. Ashley attended Dave Ramsey's counselor training class in 2013 and met other like-minded entrepreneurs who wanted to build their own coaching practices. While Ashley predominantly serves the Central Virginia region, she has had clients referred to her from across the nation and coaches them online.

Ashley's mission is to impact and improve families' lives and her vision is to make Richmond, Virginia the most abundant city

healthy behaviors with money (and communication), and holds her clients accountable when working through the system. While Ashley loves working with all of her clients, she particularly enjoys working with small business owners to help them get financially organized and to differentiate their household and business banking systems. She knows they are working toward their version of the American Dream. The most rewarding aspect for Ashley is seeing her families begin to have hope again as they look toward their futures - free of debt and full of vision - all because they learned how to build and maintain a monthly budget AND lean into the process of changing their money behaviors. One of Ashley's most recent clients stated, "I wish I had done this years ago!"

Outside of her business, Ashley is very active within the local community. One of her community projects involves the YMCA where she sits on the board for the Swift Creek YMCA (SCYMCA). 


one that Brian and Ashley feel passionate about instilling in their own children as well. All of this, in addition to regional YMCA board meetings and activities, keeps Ashley heavily engaged with her community.

In addition, Ashley recently joined the Chesterfield Chamber of Commerce, where she participates on the Government Affairs Committee. This committee focuses on legislation, policy, and helps businesses and the Chamber build relationships with the county's elected officials. She is also a member of the Executive Women International (EWI) organization. Through her membership, Ashley has participated in EWI's ASIST (Adult Students in Scholastic Transition) scholarship program, an initiative aimed at providing scholarships for men and women making a career change.
